The term will be from 3 years from January 1, 2025 to December 31 2027, with the possibility of renewal for another 3 years starting from January 2028.

The deadline for **receipt of all materials is March 15, 2024**

- A. Please include the following information in a cover letter (within 3 pages) containing:
- 1) Motivation/Vision and statement:
TPEL Editor in Chief (for regular papers, with >15hrs average weekly workload), or
TPEL Co-Editor in Chief (6-8hrs average weekly workload)
 - 2) Prior services on Editorial Boards in IEEE
 - 3) Technical Committee activities
 - 4) Possibility for host institution/company support for the candidate for the EiC or co-EiC position (e.g. release time, financial resources, etc.)
 - 5) For Co-EiC applicants, brief statement of research areas and types of papers comfortable to handle.
 - 6) Names and contact information of three references.
- B. Include also a brief 2-page resume/CV.

Interviews may be held with short listed candidates.
