IEEE Power Electronics Magazine publishes peer reviewed articles related to power electronics and its applications which encompass the effective use of electronic components, application of control theory and circuit design techniques, and the development of analytical tools used in efficient and effective energy conversion, control, utilization, and conditioning of electric power. With a focus on industry readership, the magazine topics include publication of new trend technologies that are being pursued by industry, design practices and case studies, considerable number of state-of-the-art surveys tutorials, and non-technical contributions: news about society activities, interviews, and historical articles.

The MPEL Editor-in-Chief is a paid remote, independent contractor position requiring full dedication for the success of the magazine. The incumbent is expected to provide their own workplace equipment, internet, phone, and workplace environment. The duties include but are not limited to developing an annual editorial calendar and media kit, soliciting articles per the calendar and themes, attending conferences, organizing awards, and obtaining peer reviews through ScholarOne for every article. In addition, the EiC publishes timely and industry relevant articles in each issue, organizes or directly contributing to column articles, society news, marketing/advertisement, and promotions in various avenues. The EiC also oversees and contributes to the magazine's website. The EiC is accountable to the magazine advisory board. Strong editing skills are a must.

The deadline for **receipt application materials is August 1, 2024**. Please include the following information in a cover letter (within 3 pages) containing:

- 1) Motivation/Vision and statement for MPEL Editor-in-Chief
- 2) Prior experience on Editorial Boards in IEEE or other publishers
- 3) Prior experience dealing with Comms departments of companies
- 4) A Resume/CV
- 5) Names and contact information of three references

Interviews may be held with short listed candidates.
